FINALISTS ANNOUNCED FOR 2015 WESTERN AUSTRALIAN OF THE YEAR AWARDS

The full list of finalists has been released for the 42nd annual Western Australian of the Year Awards, with nominees including Daniel Ricciardo, Frank Cooper and Ros Worthington.

A total of 26 nominees have been chosen to reflect seven categories, including arts and culture, business and the community (see full list on the following page).

The award winners will be announced at the commencement of the long weekend on Friday 29 May 2015 at a Gala Dinner at the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.

An overall Western Australian of the Year will be selected from the winners of each category.

Last year David Flanagan, Chairman of Atlas Iron Limited was granted the winning accolade.

"It's a privilege to be named Western Australian of the Year, and one that holds a special prestige for all in the past alumni," he said.

"For the finalists it's a chance to be recognised for the hard work and innovation for which Western Australians are renowned."

Celebrate WA Chairman Wayne Zekulich said these awards encourage people to celebrate the great talent within our State.

"We have so many incredible individuals in Western Australia who not only are leaders in their respective fields, but contribute significantly back to our community. It is great to be able to recognise these Western Australians as part of the WA Day long weekend celebrations."

Until 2011 the awards were known as the WA Citizen of the Year Awards. A long list of respected individuals are part of an incredibly diverse alumni that in recent years has included Professor Fiona Stanley AC, Michael Chaney AO, The Hon Chief Justice Wayne Martin AC QC and Adam Gilchrist AM.
