WINNERS ANNOUNCED FOR 2015 WESTERN AUSTRALIAN OF THE YEAR AWARDS

Dr Robert Isaacs OAM JP PhD has been awarded the State's highest honour, being named *Western Australian of the Year* at the 42nd Western Australian of the Year Awards held last night.

The Aboriginal elder had a shaky start to life, as part of the Stolen Generation he was taken from his family at just six months old and was in institutions until 17 years old. Dr Isaacs has since dedicated his life to helping improve health, housing, employment and education within Aboriginal communities.

He has achieved a number of firsts in his lifetime, becoming the first Aboriginal person to be elected to local government as Councillor and Deputy Mayor for the City of Gosnells and played a key role in setting up Australia's first Indigenous school, Clontarf Aboriginal College.

Dr Roberts has also received an Order of Australia Medal in recognition of his work to improve relations between Aboriginal people and the justice system and helping to implement programs to assist Aboriginal people achieve home ownership and housing security.

Recognising the achievements of Western Australians from a broad cross section of the community, 26 finalists were chosen across seven categories for the awards.
