WINNERS ANNOUNCED FOR WESTERN AUSTRALIAN OF THE YEAR AWARDS 2014

Mr David Flanagan has been awarded the State's highest honour, being named *Western Australian of the Year* at the 2014 Western Australian of the Year Awards held last night.

David Flanagan is a geologist by trade but he's also an entrepreneur who, in just ten years, built Australia's fifth largest iron ore exporter Atlas Iron Limited. Atlas is a top 100 ASX-listed company which employs more than 600 people and generates revenues approaching \$1 billion per annum.

David's contribution to Western Australia goes beyond the mine site. He's renowned for his personal philanthropic contributions to a variety of charities and Aboriginal organisations winning the inaugural Governor's Award for Giving in 2011. David was also the recipient of the prestigious Eisenhower Fellowship in 2013. David is the Chancellor of Murdoch University, he's on the board of Giving West and the Australian Institute of Company Directors. David is a member of the Australian Prospecting Mining Hall of Fame.
